

Safety Policy:

Broadview Product Development puts a high priority on the safety of their employees and customers. It is our policy to provide and maintain safe and healthful working conditions. A commitment to continually improve our performance through effective safety management.

Each employee has an obligation to:

Comply with safe work practices, with the intent of avoiding injury to themselves and others

Take reasonable care of the health and safety of themselves and others

Wear personal protective equipment and clothing where necessary

Comply with any direction given by management for health and safety

Not misuse or interfere with anything provided for health and safety

Report all accidents and incidents on the job immediately and report all known or observed hazards to their supervisor or manager.
